

Product Safety

Policy No. 50.05

PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for protecting the safety of persons associated with the production, handling, transportation, sale and responsible use of company products

SCOPE

All locations

POLICY

Tronox is committed to observing all applicable laws and regulations relating to the safe production, handling, transportation, use and/or sale of its products, and applying responsible standards where product safety laws and regulations do not exist.

Employees are expected to participate in ongoing efforts to identify, reduce and manage any adverse product safety impacts associated with the manufacture, transportation, sale and responsible use of company products.

As part of the company's commitment to product safety, it is company policy to:

- Identify and manage product safety considerations in the design, production, transportation, sale and responsible use of company products
- Emphasize the importance of individual support and personal accountability for the company's product safety performance and establish appropriate operating practices and training programs
- Specify precautions in handling, transporting, using and disposing of company products and take reasonable steps to communicate these

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precautions to employees, customers and others who might be affected

- Make it a priority during product planning and development to identify, reduce and prevent potential adverse effects on health, safety and the environment
- 5. Require contractors to act responsibly and in accordance with applicable product safety laws and regulations
- 6. Review and evaluate the product safety performance of company operations and actively seek opportunities for improvements

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The **product steward** (and/or designee) is responsible for assessing product safety issues and implementing appropriate controls and programs.
- 2. **Officers** or **designees** are responsible for ensuring periodic evaluation of product safety programs in conjunction with product stewardship. As needed, officers or designees will obtain technical assistance and guidance from the product steward, operations groups, and the environment, health and safety department.

CONSEQUENCES

A breach of this policy may result in disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment, in according to local policies.

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
